



Succulent and Cacti Care Instructions

Water your cacti or succulents thoroughly, but not too often. Allow them to dry out well before re-watering. There is no set rule for how often to water, as it will depend on your specific environment.

When choosing a spot for your plants, keep in mind that they enjoy sunlight. Morning light is perfect, and if you would like them in a sunnier area, you will need to acclimate them. Start with an area where they can enjoy a few hours of morning sun. After a week, move them so that they get another hour of sun per day. Then step them out to another hour the next week. Continue until you have them acclimated to the area where you intend to keep them. Temperatures between 65 and 90 degrees Fahrenheit are ideal.

If transplanting, drains well, and recommend with granite sand found in an arid weight potting low water



keep in mind that you should use a soil that a container with drain holes. We using Fertilome Cactus Mix. This coarse mix and extra perlite, duplicates conditions environment. This heavy mix performs well under application.

Use a good water soluble fertilizer every 4-6 weeks during warm weather. We recommend you use our Fertilome Water Soluble Plant Food 20-20-20. Dissolve ½ teaspoon in a gallon of water. Water your cacti or succulent until soil is thoroughly wet.
