Make a Pillowcase, Make a Difference



It's a simple idea; make a pillowcase and donate it to local charities. Whether it goes to a foster child needing love, an abused woman needing a home, an ill person needing hope, or a homeless teen needing just about everything, a small gift can be one step towards that difference. That's why **Top Stitch** is participating in the 1 Million Pillowcase Challenge organized by American Patchwork & Quilting.

Throughout 2010 we will be collecting hand-made pillowcases and donating them to the local non-profit **Community Works** which operates many programs for people in need. They are the umbrella organization for the **Dunn House** (for battered woman) the **Boys & Girls House** for foster children and a shelter for homeless runaways. They also provide training and assistance programs for at-risk families and those trying to transition from life on the streets to a life of security. We will periodically be reporting the donation numbers to the <u>1MP Challenge</u> organizers so that they can update their on-line counter.

To facilitate your help with this mission we are first introducing two programs that will run from January 4 thru October 30, 2010:

- We will have kits made up with coordinated fabrics pre-cut to size; all you
 have to do is sew up a few seams. You will pay \$10 for each kit, then when
 you bring your finished pillowcase back you will receive a \$5. in-store credit.
- The perfect excuse to use your stash! For every completed pillowcase you donate using your own fabrics you will receive a \$2 in-store credit.
- You can keep collecting credits on account up to \$100 for merchandise only;
 they will not be refundable for cash, nor can they be used for service/repairs.

You can start immediately by downloading free pillowcase patterns from www.allpeoplequilt.com/pillowcases. They will be posting additional new designs in March and also in September. If you'd like to learn more about **Community Works** go to www.community-works.org. As the project progresses we will also be looking for other local organizations that provide services for the ill (such as children with cancer) and the elderly. We welcome your help and suggestions.
