Kids Come 1st Classroom Requirements

Listed below is the policy we have for the classrooms. This is not a new policy but it is something we are struggling with. These are state regulations to ensure the best possible care for your child. Please read through carefully and feel free to ask the classrooms or office staff any questions you may have. We must follow the policy outlined below while your child is in our care.

Diapers/Wipes/Creams

We must have enough diapers wipes & creams on hand while your child is in our care. If you arrive for the day and not enough diapering supplies are available, you will be asked to return with your child when proper supplies are brought in.

EXTRA CLOTHING

Extra clothing is as important as anything else. We encourage you to keep a bag of several weather appropriate outfits in your child's cubby at all times. When the clothes are dirty we will lay them on top of your child's cubby and they need to be taken home that same day. We would appreciate if you replenished the extra supply as needed. Our extra clothes at the center are very limited and we do not have enough for everyone, so if your child is placed in KC1st extra clothes you will need to wash and return them within the week they were worn home. If it is on a Friday we will expect them washed and returned on Monday.

OUTSIDE CLOTHING

In the winter every child is expected to have a warm coat, snow pants, hat, warm/waterproof mittens and boots. In the summer you will need to provide us with sunscreen.

BLANKETS


Blankets are required for all children ages 16 months thru Pre-k. On Monday or first day of care each week, and will be sent home with you on Fridays to be washed.

If at any time your child does not have any of the above items, your child/children will not be allowed to stay. You will need to take your child/children with you and they may return with the items needed.
