Contact Lens Agreement

	1.	Always wash hands.	Keep contact lens	work area clean.

- 2. Do not get cosmetics, lotions, soaps, cream, deodorants or sprays on contacts.
- 3. Use instructed solutions. Do not use saliva or water to clean contact lens. Always use fresh unexpired lens care solutions.
- 4. Minor irritation is normal in order to adjust to contact lens. Any irritation that persists or any unusual discharge from eye, remove the contact and please contact our office.
- 5. Do not use tanning beds while wearing contact lens.
- 6. Do not sleep in contact lens, unless instructed to do so by doctor.
- 7. Follow-up appointments continue for 3 months after dispensing and are included in the fitting of contact lens.
- 8. Build up wearing time: 4 hours for the 1st 3 days. Increase an hour more each day thereafter, until reaching maximum wearing time of 10-12 hours.
- 9. Some contacts are kept in stock. Reorder lens should be called in a week ahead of depletion to insure availability. Know your contact lens prescription for each eye. Always keep a supply of replacement lenses on hand.
- 10. Do not swim or shower while wearing contacts; this can result in an eye infection or loss of contact lens.
- 11. Do not use a lens beyond expiration date.
- 12. If contact lens sticks in eye or begins to dry on the eye, apply several drops of a lubricating solution. You should wait until the lens begins to move freely on the eye before attempting to remove it. If the lens continues to stick, consult your eye doctor.
- 13. Never use tweezers or other tool to remove lenses from the lens container unless specifically indicated for that use. Pour the lens into the hand.
- 14. Do not touch the lenses with fingernails. This could cause the contact to rip or scratch the eye.
- 15. Always contact the eye care professional before using any medicine in the eyes.
- 16. Contact lens prescription is valid for 1 year. Current prescription is needed for the purchase of lenses.
