



Senior Year Comprehensive package

Description of Advising Services

This service starts summer prior to senior year to graduation, and includes the following:

- minimum of eight targeted one-on-one sessions (1 to 1.5 hours each)
- additional phone and email contact
- access to resources such as:
 - College Planner Pro subscription,
 - *College Match: A Blueprint for Choosing the Best School for You* by Dr. Stephen Antonoff
 - Lynn O'Shaughnessy's the College Solution
 - College Essay Guy webinars and text sources

Free Initial Consultation Visit: Introduce services and expectations for client and consultant. This is a no-obligation session and is not included as part of the packaged hours. The first meeting will identify student and parent goals, develop parameters for searches, and examine student interest and talents.

All formal sessions are face-to-face or via Zoom and include the following topics:

- Review Academic record
- Identify college application requirements
- Personalize timelines to apply for applications and scholarships
- Essay brainstorming and advising (up to 12 essays/personal statements)
- Financial Aid and scholarship assistance
- Analysis of admission offers and financial awards

More detailed description includes, but is not limited to:

- detailed tools to identify good fit college options (surveys and assessments)
- In-depth evaluation of academic record, curriculum, and extracurricular activities
- Matching specific academic, social, medical, and/or emotional needs with campus resources
- Reflecting on meaningful extracurricular involvements
- Individual timelines to organize the search and application process
- Determining ACT or SAT test selection, timing, and test preparation tools
- Development of personalized college lists identifying reach, target, and safety schools
- campus visit preparation
- Guidance in application preparation and meeting deadlines (up to 10)
- Suggestions for summer activities between junior and senior year
- Identifying tools to figure out college affordability (EFC, COA, and NPC)
- Assistance with the athletic recruitment and/or fines arts process
- Post-application assistance including final choices, scholarship review and financial aid
