## Estimating Guide \& Formulas of Stone

## 1. Mulch \& Gravel Coverage:

a. 1 ton covers approximately:
200 sq. ft. at $1^{\prime \prime}$ depth 100 sq. ft. at 2" depth 70 sq. ft at 3" depth
35 sq. ft at 6" depth
20 sq. ft. at 98" depth
b. 1 cu. yard covers approximately:
300 sq. ft. at 1 " depth
150 sq. ft. at 2" depth 100 sq. ft. at 3" depth
50 sq. ft. at 6" depth
30 sq. ft. at 9: depth
Rule of Thumb: 1.5 tons
per cu. yd.
a. 6 wheel barrow loads per cu. yd.
1 cu. yd. $=27 \mathrm{cu} . \mathrm{ft}$. $1 \mathrm{cu} . \mathrm{yd} .=202 \mathrm{gal}$.

## 2. Wall Stone \& Flagging:

A. Drywall Stone: 12 to 15 face ft./ton (1 ton will build a wall approx. 1'x 1'x 15').
B. Flagging 1 " = about 12 lb./sq. ft. = (Approx. 150 sq. ft./ton)

Flagging 1-1 1/2" thick-about 20 lbs./sq. ft. = approx. 100 sq. ft. +/per ton.
C. Belgian Block: 1 ton will cover approx. 40 sq. ft. of paving.
