

JOLLEY PRECAST BASEMENT ENTRANCE JOB SITE REQUIREMENTS



PRE-INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Foundation opening should not be more than 40".
- 2. Foundation should be clean, plumb and square . Any defects such as honeycomb should be patched.
- 3. Foundation coating should be kept back 12" from opening in foundation.
- 4. Footing should be clean and level.
- 5. Measure height from footing to finished grade to determine size of casting needed.
- 6. Precast concrete casting should extend 3" to 6" above finished grade.
- 7. Footing drains should be installed with smooth wall pipe and covered with filter fabric.
- 8. Provide access for truck to the basement entrance area.



POST-INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Finish coating foundation up to and around casting.
- 2. Properly backfill with clean, suitable fill. DO NOT BURY BUILDING MATERIALS OR CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS.
- 3. We recommend installing 2" Styrofoam on underside of casting to prevent heaving from frost.
- 4. Leave finished grade 3" to 6" below the top of casting.
- 5. Slope grade away from bulkhead in all directions.
- 6. Install trim and siding around the metal doors.
- 7. Install gutters on roof to divert water away from bulkhead.
- 8. Avoid installing downspouts or sump pump discharges near the bulkhead.
- 9. The door is primed. Paint all metal surfaces, inside and out, with a finish coat of alkyd metal enamel in a light color. DO NOT USE AN OIL BASE WOOD PAINT.
- 10. Install an insulated door at the bottom of stairs to prevent heat loss.
